

## TOWN OF ROSE – REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING

January 10, 2022

Meeting was brought to order by Chair Apps at 7:00pm.

Members Present: Chair Apps, Supervisors Perez and Cutts, Clerk VandeCastle, and Treasurer Roger Williams.

Others Present: None

Motion was made by Supv. Cutts, seconded by Supv. Perez, to approve the agenda as presented.  
Motion carried.

Minutes of the 12/13/21 meeting were read by all. Motion was made by Chair Apps, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to accept the minutes of the 12/13/21 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

The Treasurer Report was read and discussed by all. The Legion Hall rent was discussed. It was paid using the increased rate of \$50 / use. Motion was made by Supv. Perez, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to accept the Treasurer Report and pay the bills as presented. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT: None.

OLD BUSINESS: The roads are looking good. Apache is a little bumpy, but they are all widened out nicely. The Board is happy about the plowing this year. The drifting on 13<sup>th</sup> was taken care of. Another street marker sign is missing at Apache and 15<sup>th</sup>. This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> time in the same area. Supv. Cutts will contact Mike to discuss how to keep the signs from being stolen.

Chair Apps checked on Badger and 18<sup>th</sup>. There is currently no indication of any muskrats, and the water level is down. Chair Apps has contacted the DNR but has had no response.

There is nothing new to report on the Town Forestry Plan.

Chair Apps contacted Karl Atkinson at the County Highway Department about the No ATV/UTV signs. Rent-a-Flash carries the signs also. The 18"x18" sign is \$17, and the 24"x24" sign is \$25. The Board will need to decide how many signs are needed. Chair Apps will get together with Karl to discuss the signs.
