

## TOWN OF ROSE – REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING

April 20, 2021

Meeting was brought to order by Chair Apps at 7:00pm.

Chair Apps and the Board thanked out-going Supervisors Bob Mushinski and Doc Kloes for their years of service for the Town of Rose. Chair Apps then welcomed in-coming Supervisors Joe Perez and Chris Cutts to the Board. All Board members were sworn in.

Members Present: Chair Apps, Supervisors Perez and Cutts, Clerk VandeCastle, and Treasurer Roger Williams.

Others Present: Mike Urban and Bob Mushinski

Motion was made by Chair Apps, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Minutes of the 3/8/21 meeting were read by all. Motion was made by Supv. Perez, seconded by Chair Apps, to accept the minutes of the 3/8/21 meeting. Motion carried.

The Treasurer Report was read and discussed by all. Mike Urban mentioned that a couple of people inquired why Paul Sczeblewski from Hudziak's charged for helping with the tree clearing when he took some wood for himself. Mike explained that Paul only charged for the equipment used, not his time. Motion was made by Chair Apps, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to accept the Treasurer Report and pay the bills as presented. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT: None.

OLD BUSINESS: Mike will pick up some cold mix at the Highway Department to fill some potholes throughout the Township. Mike said there seem to be more potholes this year than last. A sign is missing at 14<sup>th</sup> and Cty. Rd. P. Muskrats are digging under the road on Badger. Chair Apps met with Brian from the Highway Department to discuss possible solutions. The Board began discussion on proposed road work for this year. Brian gave some estimates for possible work. Twin Lake Road needs seal coating and wedging on the curve. 14<sup>th</sup> will be paved by the County when County Road P is being paved. 14<sup>th</sup> was pulverized last fall. The Board will bring road work ideas to the next meeting for discussion. The spraying from last year looks good. More spraying will be done this year. Bob Mushinski noted that Apache needs to be sprayed again in some places.

The current forestry plan goes through the end of 2022. Ben Preston from Bell is working on a new plan, free of charge. Ben has not gotten back to Bob Mushinski yet regarding the plan. Bob will continue to be the contact for the forestry plan. Bob also discussed the Karner Blue Butterfly Prairie Restoration project. Everything stopped due to COVID. Hopefully more spraying will be done this year. We still have some money to pay for our share of the \$11,000 grant.

Accurate Appraisal is under contract for 2021. The Board has nothing new to report on finding a new assessor.
