

TOWN OF ROSE – REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING

July 12, 2021

Meeting was brought to order by Chair Apps at 7:00pm.

Members Present: Chair Apps, Supervisors Perez and Cutts, Clerk VandeCastle, and Treasurer Roger Williams.

Others Present: Mike Urban

Motion was made by Supv. Perez, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to approve the agenda as presented.

Motion carried.

Minutes of the 6/14/21 meeting were read by all. Motion was made by Chair Apps, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to accept the minutes of the 5/10/21 meeting. Motion carried.

The Treasurer Report was read and discussed by all. Shaping for paving costs from the County were for Twin Lakes. ARPA money was discussed. Motion was made by Supv. Perez, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to accept the Treasurer Report and pay the bills as presented. Motion carried.

Chair Apps attended a fire district meeting. Minutes from the previous fire district meeting were distributed. The roof has been installed on the training building.

Chair Apps noted that the dirt roads in the Township all look good. Mike will check on some spots where the blacktop is breaking away. Board members and Mike were encouraged make a list of spots that need shoulder repair and need spraying. These areas will be discussed at the August meeting and the list will be given to the County.
